

Merger of Three Police Security Unions Creates “United Federation LEOS-PBA” a Major New Union Representing More than 5,000 Officers Nationwide.

NEW YORK, NY -- March 3, 2021 -- The ***United Federation LEOS-PBA***, a major new police security union with more than 5,000 Members, was officially launched today bringing together three formerly independent 9(b)3 labor organizations; The United Federation of Special Police & Security Officers (UFSPSO), The National Union of Special Police Officers (NUSPO), and Law Enforcement Officers Security & Police Benevolent Association LEOS-PBA and its affiliated Unions LEOSU, LEOSU-CA, LEOSU-DC, LEOSU-PI & the National Union of Nuclear Security Officers NUNSO.

In making the announcement today, Charles “Chip” Strebeck, formerly President of UFSPSO and President of the newly formed United Federation LEOS-PBA, said; “Bringing together three important 9(b)3 Security Police labor unions and the more than 5,000 Officers they represent, provides our Members with a stronger voice at the bargaining table as we continue to fight for higher wages, enhanced benefits, decent working conditions, and guaranteed job security for our Officers and their families.”
